- 1. Have your child ride the school bus.
- 2. Set up a carpool with your neighbors/friends.
- 3. Arrive at school between 7:30-7:40 a.m.

Additional ways to help the process move quicker include:

- 1. Be mindful of the people waiting behind you and say a quick good-bye.
- 2. Refrain from driving next to your child and talking to them as they walk along the sidewalk. Please pull away to make room for other cars.
- 3. Remain in the line. Do not park and walk your child across the driveway. We have had several near misses.
