#### **School Lunch Update**

We want to remind our families that our district is providing *free* meals to all students. The USDA has extended its free meal program option to all districts that want to offer free meals to their students for this school year. The USDA is also providing additional support and flexibility for school districts to continue serving meals to children while maintaining safety measures and managing the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Unfortunately, included in the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic are nationwide supply chain and product availability shortages. Disruptions are due to a lack of availability of raw ingredients and labor to produce, unload, and transfer food products. Some food and/or beverage products normally provided to students may not be available or arrive as scheduled. Due to unforeseen circumstances, last-minute menu changes and product substitutions may occur. Be assured meals will remain balanced, healthy, and plentiful. We ask for patience and understanding as we do our best to meet the needs of your children.

Our lunch menus are available <u>online</u> but we have had to temporarily suspend the nutritional information we were able to provide in the past. Please know that we are trying to keep to our menus as best we can, but we do not have control over the food supply chain. Should you need

specific ingredient information on an item, you will need to call your school's kitchen at: 952-401-6880 to have a staff member read the ingredient list for you.
